



2025 Torquay Hotel Multihull Challenge Notice of Race

The Torquay Hotel Multihull Challenge hosted by the Hervey Bay Sailing Club will be held on the 29th and 30th November on the waters of beautiful Hervey Bay. This event is open to all classes of off the beach catamarans and multihulls.

1 RULES. The Regatta will be governed by Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions and regulations of Australian Sailing, and the current rules of classes competing, this notice of race and the sailing instructions.

2 ENTRY. All classes of off the beach catamarans and multihulls are eligible to compete in the Torquay Hotel Multihull Challenge. A competing boat must comply with specific class and measurement rules. Entry details. mysailingclub.com.au/event/GHKAQ

3 FEES. Regatta fees shall be \$70.00 per boat or \$40.00 per day.

4 FLEETS. Fleet 1- Catamarans/Multihulls with AS Yardstick 78 or higher

Fleet 2- Catamarans/Multihulls with AS Yardstick less than 78

4.1 Weta Fleet shall compete pending number of entries.

4.2 Race Committee may decide to change, add or combine fleets.

6 RACING. The racing area will be that part of Hervey Bay that is north and west of the Clubhouse.

7 COURSES. The courses will be short courses as described in the Sailing Instructions.

8 SCORING. The low points scoring system will apply.

9 PRIZES. Individual prizes will be awarded in relation to the number of boats in competing fleets.
